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3. Emburga - Totale (14 km)
 5.5 hours 4 easy
 A peaceful and scenic stretch of the River Liepupe - perfect for a leisurely day on the water. The Liepupe is easy, with a gentle current, suitable for beginners and families with children. The route offers typical Zemgale scenery - wide curves interspersed with long straight.

4. Pasta Island rowing base - Pasta Island - Observation tower on the Palace Island - Governor's Island - Pasta Island (6.5 km)
 3 hours 4 easy
 While boating you can enjoy the scenery of the Liepupe floodplain meadows and views of the nature park "Svētā floorplan", which stands out for its natural diversity and scenic beauty. This easy route is suitable for beginners and families with children. Only on the river if using the services of "Causpīdigo un cita veida laivu noma". For individual boating, entry and disembarking only in agreement with the "Rūķi" recreation area, +371 2954714.

2. Mēstine - Stāļene (18 km)
 1 day 4 easy
 Get into the river in Bauska and get out in Jelgava Municipality!
 The route is easy, with a gentle current, suitable for beginners and families with children. The route is navigable throughout the whole season and can be extended or shortened at will. Along the way you can enjoy scenic views of the Zemgale plan.

The River Svēte rises in Svaļiņi district, Zemgale, and part of its course forms the Latvia-Lithuania border. The River Svēte is suitable for boating only in spring, when the water level is high enough. In summer, the water level is too low in many places. In autumn, after heavy rains, the river may become navigable again. It is navigable by canoe, but the two-sided paddles of a kayak may be too long to paddle through some of the narrower reed funnels. The recommended navigable stretch is from Jēkabpils to Jelgava, where there are also enjoying possibilities.

1. Svēte from Vētrās - bridge over Svēte (Jelgava) (17 km)
 4 hours 4 medium
 Spring stream adventure on the River Svēte. It offers narrow rapids, wider pond-like funnels. The route is of medium difficulty and can only be navigated in spring at high water level.

2. Jēkabpils - bridge over the Svēte (Jelgava) (21 km)
 7 hours 4 medium
 The route starts in Jēkabpils at the bridge over the River Svēte and continues to Jelgava. The route can be shortened by a few km by starting boating in Vētrās. On the way you can stop and see the exhibition of the Svēte Castle by prior arrangement. Recommended only at the spring stream; in summer, very low water level in places.

The River Bērze is a left tributary of the Svēte in the Dobele and Jelgava municipalities. Both large and small fallen trees can be expected in the river. To cross some of them you will have to carry your boat along the shore. Small rapids are expected, formed by both aquatic plants and rock piles. At the Bērze flood gates, boats will have to be carried ashore, but the river here is very scenic. In winter, the river can be shallow and you will have to drag the boats, so cross or rubber slippers are the best footwear for boating on the Bērze. The river is rocky and barefoot walking is not recommended. Be aware that the Bērze is quite overgrown and many sections may be impassable, in shallower areas you may have to push the boat. The Bērze is a diverse river with many rapids and shallow, which makes boating interesting. Boating is possible throughout the ice-free season, best during floods until May and after heavy rains.

1. Terrace "Dobele pils skaņi" - HPP Dam (1.5 km)
 1.5 hours 4 medium
 Offers relaxing boating for one and a half kilometers along the River Bērze from the terrace of SIA "Dobele pils skaņi" in the direction of Dobele Music School to the HPP. Along the way you can see the remarkable Svaļiņi Castle, the Pīnās Street terraces and the Dobele Castle. Ruins walking promenade. Provides entry, exit only if using the "Dobele pils skaņi" boat rental service.

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5. Jelgava Water Tourism and Sports base - VSAČ - Zemgale - branch "Jelgava" (6 km)
 3 hours 4 easy
 A chance to enjoy two rivers. During the trip you can enjoy views of the Liepupe floodplain meadows, offering a scenic and peaceful trip. The route is easy, suitable for families and beginners. This is a great opportunity to enjoy the peace of nature interspersed with long straight.

6. Jelgava Water Tourism and Sports base - recreation area "Rūķi" (10 km)
 4 hours 4 easy
 While boating you can enjoy the scenery of the Liepupe floodplain meadows and views of the nature park "Svētā floorplan", which stands out for its natural diversity and scenic beauty. This easy route is suitable for beginners and families with children. Only on the river if using the services of "Causpīdigo un cita veida laivu noma". For individual boating, entry and disembarking only in agreement with the "Rūķi" recreation area, +371 2954714.

1. Jelgava TIC, www.visit.jelgava.lv
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The River Misa is a right tributary of the liecava, offering a changing and exciting boating experience. In spring it is easily navigable with high water levels, but in summer the water drops, exposing obstacles such as fallen trees and beaver banks, which provide a real challenge for adventurers. The routes also offer the chance to enjoy the charm of three rivers - the Misa, the liecava and the Liepupe. The best season for boating is spring, when the water level is high. Autumn can be a second-best option, depending on the weather.

1. Dalbe - Ozolnieki (17 km)
 3 hours 4 easy
 Rivers Misa and liecava - winding waterways and exciting discovery!
 This easy route with a weak current is suitable for beginners and families with children, offering a scenic and interesting journey. The Misa and Dalbe meanders, leading you to enjoy its overgrown, green banks, which turn into a landscape of private houses close to Ozolnieki. At the mouth of the Misa in liecava are the fortifications of the Sigulda Fortification from Napoleonic times. The route is navigable throughout the whole season and can be adapted - extended or shortened - at will.

2. Dalbe - Jelgava (25 km)
 9 hours 4 medium
 A three-river adventure - Misa, liecava and Liepupe!

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The River Vircava is a tributary of the left bank of the River Liecava, which starts in Lithuania, Svaļiņi region, and continues in Latvia - Jelgava Municipality. It flows northwards through the Zemgale plain. The basin is long and narrow; the riverbed is rocky and streightened in most parts of its course. In summer the Vircava is often a large ditch, although it is wider and partly navigable in the lower reaches, but its most interesting sections are navigable only at the high-water level. The Vircava is suitable for families with children and for those who prefer relaxed boating. The routes also offer excellent opportunities to boat in the Rivers Liepupe, Dīkša and liecava.

1. Lievīcava - Jelgava (Hotel "Seniči") (19 km)
 3 hours 4 medium
 Spring boating adventure on the River Vircava!
 This route of medium difficulty leads from Lievīcava to Jelgava (restaurant "Zemnieku ceņš") and can only be enjoyed at the high-water level. The Vircava is suitable for families with children and for those who prefer relaxed boating. The routes also offer excellent opportunities to boat in the Rivers Liepupe, Dīkša and liecava.

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1. Bauska - Mēzotne (10 km)
 4 hours 4 easy
 This is a classic and scenic River Liepupe route - from Bauska to Mēzotne, with a possible rest break in Jūrmaru Park or Jūga Music and Art Centre "Ceļiņi". The route is easy, with a weak current, suitable for beginners and families with children, and can be boated all season long. It can be extended or shortened as you wish.

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The River Daugava is the largest river in Latvia and one of the national symbols of Latvia, who call it "Mother Daugava". The "River of Destiny" of the nation, and sing it in stories and songs. Boating on the Daugava in the Jūkabpils Municipality offers a dynamic and exciting adventure - with rapids and fast currents that guarantee vivid impressions. The initially calm current becomes increasingly swift and filled with rapids. This stretch also features picturesque Daugava islets and sandy swimming areas. The section of the Daugava with the most rapids, including the strongest in Latvia, the White Rapids and the 3.5 km long Pīri Rapids, is located near Jēkabpils in the direction of Rīga. Further on, the river becomes calmer, but it is not suitable for beginners with little experience. Canoes or kayaks are recommended as they manoeuvre well in the wind. On the Aizkraukle side, please note that it is not possible to boat across the Pīri Rapids. If you like the rapids, start to circle around the rushes and go through it several times, later the other rapids of the Daugava will follow one after another. You can linger on one of the islets with sandy beaches. On the right bank of the Daugava, there is a spectacular steep bank, do not miss the sign to Rūgāļi ravine and stone, where you can refresh yourself with clear spring water.

1. Daugava waterway (40 km)
 1-2 days 4 medium
 This is a one or two-day adventure trip. Here the initially calm flow of the Daugava becomes increasingly swift and filled with rapids. As you explore the small islands in Daugava, sandy beaches are revealed. The calmer stretches, for example from Lievāni to Jēkabpils, are suitable for families with children, as they can enjoy the beauty of nature and the amazing view of the bridge over the Misa at Cēna and heading to Ozolnieki along the waters of the Misa and liecava. The medium difficulty section offers natural beauty and variable flow, but shallow and possible obstacles must be taken into account. Suitable for experienced boaters and active adventurers.

2. Līvāni - "Daugales" (13 km)
 3-4 hours 4 medium
 The initially calm flow of the river becomes more and more rapid, and at this point

3. Cēna - Jelgava (19 km)
 7 hours 4 medium
 The route passes through the Misa, liecava and Liepupe waterways, offering an exciting day on the water with varied scenery and wide curves. During the trip, you can enjoy the beauty of nature and experience the character of three different rivers - the narrowness of the Misa, the calm of the liecava and the vastness of the Liepupe. The route is suitable for those who want a full day's adventure.

4. Eitīns - Ozolnieki (28 km)
 2 days 4 medium
 An exciting two-day adventure where the Misa and the liecava meet, offering the diversity and tranquility of nature! The route starts in Eitīns and ends in Jelgava Municipality, giving you the opportunity to enjoy the flow and dynamics of several rivers. Suitable for experienced boaters.

5. Kalmes - Ozolnieki (33 km)
 3 days 4 medium
 For nature and adventure lovers - three days on the waters of the Rivers Misa and liecava, where the flow and scenery change every moment! The route starts in Olaine and ends in Jelgava Municipality, giving you a varied experience as several rivers are encountered along the way. The route is suitable for experienced boaters, with shallower sections and obstacles that require attention and dexterity.

6. Cēna - Ozolnieki (11 km)
 3 hours 4 medium
 An exciting one-day route starting at the bridge over the Misa at Cēna and heading to Ozolnieki along the waters of the Misa and liecava. The medium difficulty section offers natural beauty and variable flow, but shallow and possible obstacles must be taken into account. Suitable for experienced boaters and active adventurers.

7. Pīternieki - goat farm "Liciņi" (16 km)
 6 hours 4 easy
 An ideal route for a peaceful and scenic day on the River Misa, suitable for beginners and families with children! The route starts in Pīternieki and ends at the goat farm "Liciņi", which provides a unique opportunity to enjoy the silence and harmony of nature. An easy and safe journey without major obstacles, with a pleasant flow. Please note that the exit is possible if using the "Ozolaivas laivu noma" rental "Mučas" in agreement with "Liciņi", +371 26453155 (paid service).

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1. Bauska - Mēzotne (10 km)
 4 hours 4 easy
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 This is a classic and scenic River Liepupe route - from Bauska to Mēzotne, with a possible rest break in Jūrmaru Park or Jūga Music and Art Centre "Ceļiņi". The route is easy, with a weak current, suitable for beginners and families with children, and can be boated all season long. It can be extended or shortened as you wish.

The River Liepupe is the largest river in Zemgale and was also the second most important and of the most scenic rivers in Latvia. The Liepupe will be more interesting in the upper section, where the banks are steeper and rapids can be felt at lower water (some 27 km from Bauska Embargo). The Liepupe starts at Bauska, meeting the Rivers Mēmele and Misa, and flows into the Baltic Sea in the Gulf of Riga in the east of the town of Jūrmala. Boating on the Liepupe offers a wide range of possibilities - from short trips to multi-day expeditions.

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
