1 Aknīste Town

A beautiful small town on the banks of Suseja River.

4 Pilkalne Manor

The centre of the manor consists of the servants' residential place, outbuildings and a barn - the forge, where a unique grain drying oven has been preserved. The buildings include a beautiful, well-kept park with veteran trees.

6 Kurmene Church and Manor's Complex

You can walk around and see the restored manor barn, the park with a pond, and the Catholic church. The park has a clay pottery kiln and animal shelters housing ostriches, sheep, llamas, alpacas and other unique animals.

7 Brukna Manor

The original owners of Brukna Manor (until 1920) are considered to be members of the German-Baltic aristocratic family - Baron Korff. The manor ensemble was built in the mid-18th century, but its current appearance is a neoclassical rebuild from the 19th century.

8 Recreation Complex "Miķelis"

The farmstead consists of a residential house, drying barn, shed, two barns, a stable and a forge. You can see a collection of old vehicles - cars, trucks and fire engines, various agricultural machinery, motorcycles and engines, more than 100 pieces of machinery in total.

1 Asare Manor and Park

Several buildings from the manor period can be seen - a church, ruins of a manor house (castle), and the gardener's and manager's residential houses. Asares Manor was built in 1749 in the neo-Gothic style, but it burned down in 1927.
